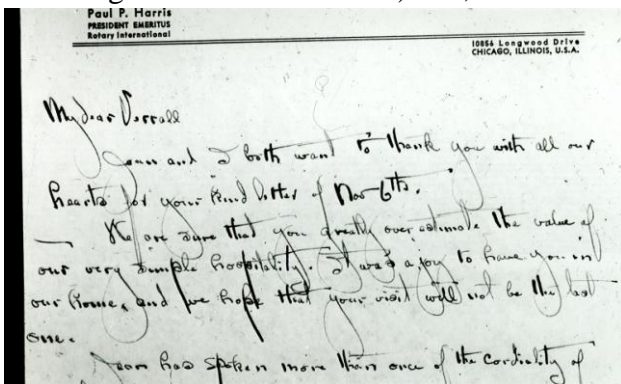


Review of August Meetings - Membership and extension month.

Rotarians respond quickly to Pakistan floods

Across Great Britain and Ireland, Rotary clubs are working hard to raise funds following the devastating floods in Pakistan. In the immediate aftermath of this natural disaster, victims are looking for shelter, warmth, food and clean water. [Water Survival Box](#), [Aquabox](#) and [ShelterBox](#) can provide life-saving aid where it is needed most.

In just 48 hours, ShelterBoxes were sent. Inside each box is a ten-person tent and survival equipment to keep a family going for several months but more help is urgently needed.

Two hundred Water-Survival Boxes, the bulk of the stock available at the time, were offered to Humanity First UK.

HF-UK. Staff worked hard to ensure swift transit through customs and distribution to families most in need. A second consignment of 200 Water Survival Boxes left the UK on Saturday 14th August on a flight to Islamabad where Humanity First UK collected and distributed them.
